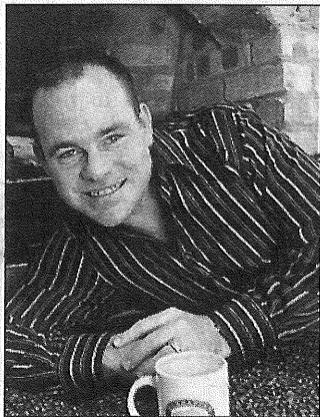


Coffees advance Australia Fair
