Black Giraffe

Burleigh Brewing Co's (BBC) Bit on the Side department has released a limited edition beer called Black Giraffe, which it claims is the only coffee beer developed on the Gold Coast. To create the product, BBC's brew master Brennan Fielding worked with Kenton Campbell, the owner of Zarraffa's Coffee, a local company whose name means giraffe in Arabic. The black beer is contained in a long-neck collectable bottle with a screen-printed label that carries the slogan "Long legs with a Burleigh head". Peta Fielding, CEO of BBC, said the company love the chance to 'play around a little'. "We love beer and we love creating beer that excites people", she said. "Black Giraffe was an idea that, over six months, we were able to bring to life and now we can't wait to hear what the public thinks." In March, the department's first release My Wife's Bitter sold out in just a few weeks. Only 600 cartons of the black beer are being produced and these will be predominantly sold in independent bottle shops in Queensland, New South Wales and Victoria.
